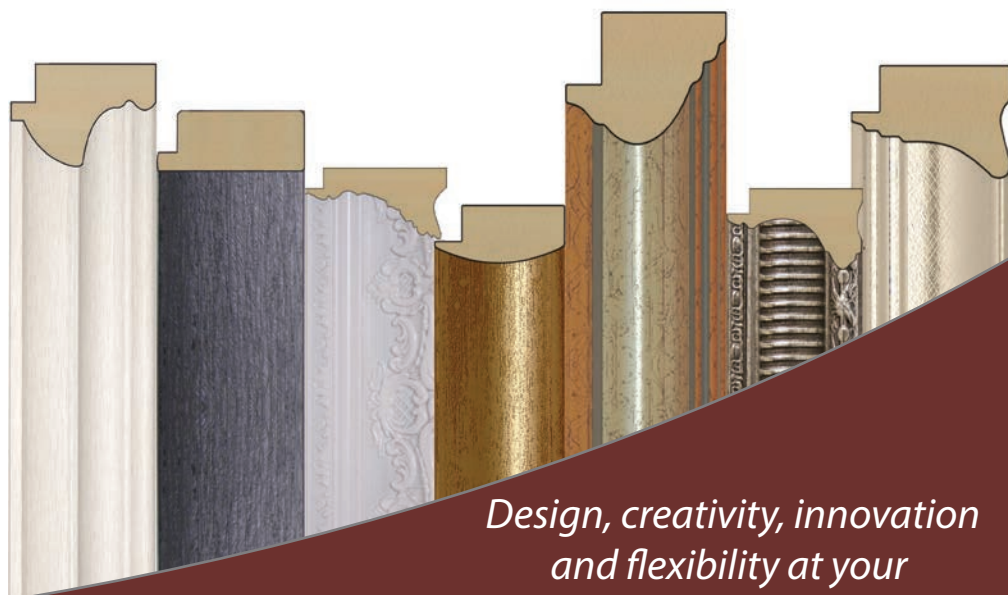

MANUFACTURING

Supreme Mouldings manufacturing is based in the river port city of East London, with a factory floor area of 10 000 square metres. The factory has a capacity in excess of 700 000 metres per month. The factory strives to maintain a balance between production throughput and quality. Quality is a continuous process that is woven into the fabric of the factory and serves to ensure that everything that leaves the factory floor exceeds customer expectations. The management team has over 200 years combined manufacturing experience.

Our QC department is supported by one of South Africa's leading analytical polymer science laboratories, based in Stellenbosh.

Having our own Research and Development department allows us to cater for individual clients needs as well as enabling us to remain at the forefront of market trends.

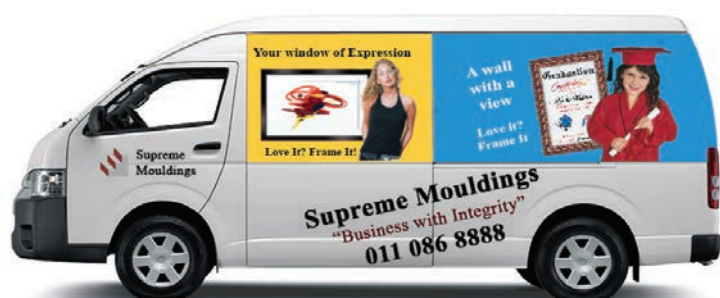
SALES, MARKETING AND DISTRIBUTION

The Supreme Mouldings head office, main warehousing and distribution is located in Robertville, Johannesburg with branches, warehousing and distribution in Cape Town and Durban. The warehouses carry the full product range and local delivery is generally within 24 hours of placing the order. Courier orders are dispatched within 48 hours.

80% of sales are into the domestic market, with the balance going into other African countries as well as the USA, Russia and Europe.

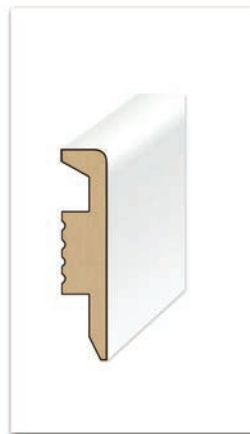


ARCHITECTURAL

Some of the product features include:

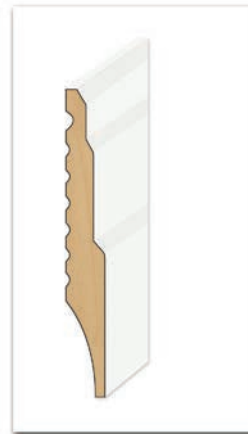
- Made from up to **100%** recycled polystyrene. The product is also recyclable.

- Will never warp.



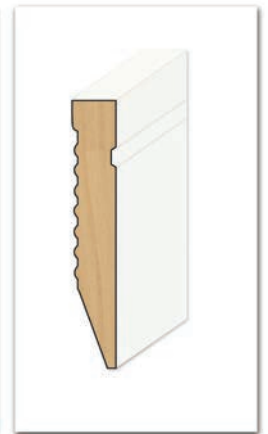
75mm Slimline

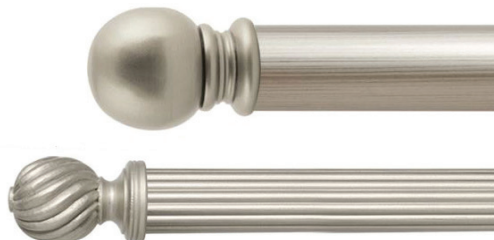

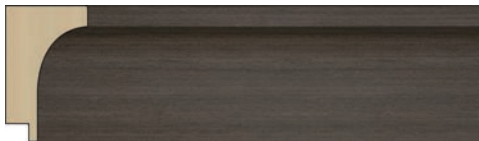

SUPREME MOULDINGS RECYCLING PROGRAMME

Driven by the need to reduce raw material costs and at the same time wanting to take our place as an environmentally conscious company, a nationwide polystyrene collection network was established in 2006.

This programme currently collects in excess of 100 tons of waste polystyrene a month. This waste polystyrene previously found its way in to landfill, rivers and the ocean.

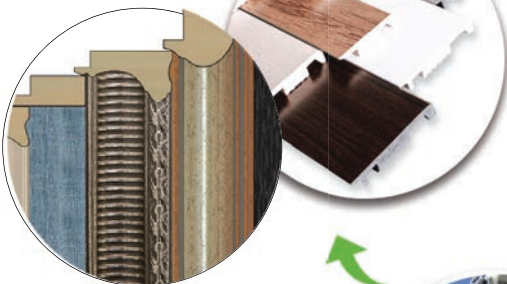
1. Non biodegradable polystyrene is a major component of plastic debris in the ocean and is extremely dangerous to our marine life and wildlife.



2. Supreme sends out trucks daily to collect in Johannesburg, Cape Town, East-London, Uitenhage, Durban and Pretoria. We collect in excess **1200 tons** each year.

The Recycling Process

4. The ingots are chipped and made into pellets which are recycled then blended together with other material to make our lengths of mouldings, which are then coloured and foiled for boxing and distribution.



3. Once collected, the polystyrene goes through the process of being melted and compressed into square blocks called ingots and then transported down to our manufacturing plant in East-London.
